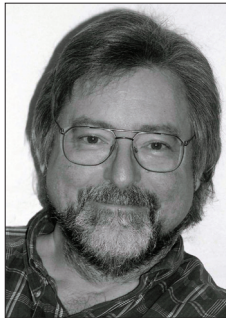


Creating a Sacred Space

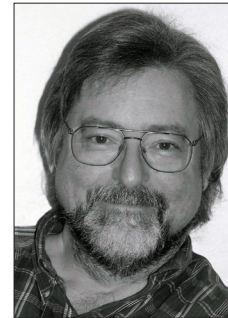

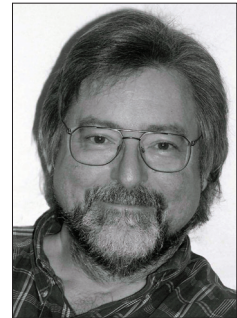
